INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUSTRALIAN ACE 2007

Introduction

1. This year marks Australia's inaugural involvement in the ACE program. The Western Australia Australian Army Cadets Brigade will host the exchange in Perth, Western Australia from 7 – 21 July 2007.

Travel Details

2. All Escorts and cadets should arrive at Perth (PER) on the 7th Jul 07 between 1200-1400 or as close to that time as flights will allow. Return flights should be planned to depart Perth from midday 21st Jul 07. Once known, travel details and flight information should be forwarded to the AAC ACE liaison officer.
