CARIBBEAN CADET CAMP 2008

1. General. Based on a decision taken at the 2007 Commandants' Conference in Jamaica, the St. Vincent and the Grenadines Cadet Force will host the Caribbean Cadet Camp and the Commandants Conference 2008.
2. Theme. The theme for CCC 2008 will be **'The Caribbean Cadet Experience a Unifying Force.'**
3. Code Name. The camp will be conducted under the code name, **'Camp Yurumein.'**
4. Schedule of Events. The proposed Schedule of Events is as follows:

a.	Caribbean contingents arrive	17 th July, 2008
b.	Official opening Ceremony	19 th July, 2008
c.	Commandant's conference	26 th July, 2008
d.	Closing Ceremony / Parade	27 th July, 2008
e.	Departures	28 th July, 2008
5. Concept. The camp will feature a combination of military and non military training, competitions and social activities for local and overseas Cadets with a minimum of two year cadetting experience. The activities will be conducted in the following three segments:
 - a. Main Events (Military training)
 - b. Primary Training (Civil)
 - c. Competitions (Military and Non-Military)

(1) Pamphlets outlining in detail, the training to be conducted during each segment would be prepared and circulated.

(2) The competition segment will be conducted on the basis of teams representing the various contingents.

(3) Contingents would be grouped into companies for administrative control and for training purposes

6. Participants. Cadet Corps/Forces from the countries listed hereunder are invited to send contingents.

7. Composition. Each contingent should comprise a maximum of **16 cadets and officers**. It is proposed that there must be a minimum of **seven (7) males** and five (5) female cadets. There must be one male and one female adult officer responsible for each contingent.

8. Confirmation of attendance. Cadet Corps/Forces should confirm their participation no later than the **31st January, 2008**.
